T-TESS APPRAISAL CALENDAR**

Key Date: August 3, 2018

Orientation for teachers new to district.

Key Date: September 27, 2018

All teachers (returning and new to district) are required to complete Part I in DMAC (**Goal Setting and Professional Development Plan**).

Key Date: April 1-May 3

Teachers must complete Part II in DMAC (Goal Reflection) prior to End of Year Conference with Principal.

Span of dates for End of Year conferences. The teacher receives the end-of-year evaluation two (2) days **after the end-of-year conference**. After the End of Year conference, the teacher completes Part III (Future Goals).

Key Date: **May 3, 2019**

Final day to complete an end of year conference with the principal.

Key Date: **June 6, 2019**

Summative Report and observation chart is due to Central Office.

Appraisers shall give teachers a one week observation window, and have a conference within ten working days after the observation. All attempts will be made to share within 48 hours as recommended by T-TESS. Teachers may request a second formal appraisal within 10 days of the first formal conference. WalkThroughs may occur at any time. Pre-conferences are optional at discretion of principal.

All T-TESS teacher evaluations shall follow OCISD Policy DNA(Legal) and DNA (Local). The appraisal period for each teacher includes all the days of a teacher's contract..

Observations must not occur:

- The day before or after any holiday
- On any date STAAR tests are administered and you have been selected to be a test administrator (campus or district-wide) on a day that a teacher is to give district-mandated assessments (STAAR Field Testing, NAEP, EOC field testing, semester tests, and other standardized tests).
